We've got another great selection of Beers this year, from Stonehenge to Settle and Wylye to Winchester! New breweries to the festival this year include Rude Giant from down the road in Wylye, and Flower Pots - based on a recommendation from a man in the know! We're also delighted to host 2 beers from Southwark Brewery, London. We were Southwark's first ever customer back in 2014!

Tom has curated a cider line-up capable of quenching any thirst, and head over and see Gary on the Gin bar as it morphs into a Craft Spirits destination with some amazing Rums and Vodkas joining the line up too this year.

Last year we saw the Steve Wyre Trophy awarded to Triple F brewery for their Satisfaction Brown Ale. The trophy is awarded each year to the beer of the festival, in memory of our inspirational chairman Steve Wyre.

Please Note: If you have paid the reduced entrance fee for the Saturday Afternoon Session only, you must leave the festival at the end of the afternoon session, or pay to upgrade to the full evening session and receive a wrist band.

The Beer....

Animal Brewing Co. - Aylesbury, Buckinghamshire

Fruit Bat - ABV 4.6% - A Golden pale ale, hopped with Simcoe single hops for a fruity, earthy flavours, carrying notes of berry, peach, apricot and citrus with a pronounced pine aroma.

Pelican - ABV 4.6% - A gorgeous US Blonde ale with more Azacca and Cascade. Flavours of grapefruit, lychees and mangos strike the palate while oats and wheat are added for extra body.

Bell Inn Nano Brewery - Wylye, Wiltshire

Olde English Ale - ABV 5.5% - Pours a very dark ruby with a foamy tan head and lightly carbonated in the tradition of British Ales. Sweet malts and dark fruits on the nose. Toffee, bitter roasted malt, cherry and plum on the palate. Full bodied, velvety smooth and on the sweet side but with a hint of bitterness for balance. Very moreish.

Carriers Arms Porter - ABV 4.2% - The blend of dark malts and English hops provide an earthy and creamy character. The smoked coffee foretaste gives way to hints of dark fruit, molasses and chocolate. A surprisingly light and refreshing flavoursome ale.

Cerne Abbas Brewery, Cerne Abbas, Dorse

Blonde - ABV 4.2% - Pale beer, a blend of American and antipodean hops, noted for a crisp and refreshing finish with a hoppy nose. Maris Otter Low colour malt base from Dorset barley.

Hopstomper - ABV 4.0% - An American influenced pale ale with a full hoppy flavour. As the name suggests, perfect for stomping about in a barn with! (Who writes this guff?!!?).

Downton Brewery, Downton, Wiltshire

Opening Score - ABV 4.5% - this easy-drinking IPA has a herbal and floral bitterness balanced with a light, malty backbone. Australian and American hops ensure the aroma and flavour is packed full of citrus and stone fruit.

Stonefish IPA - ABV 3.0% - First there's the tropical fruit flavours of mango and lychee from a special blend of Aussie hops. Then comes a balanced bitterness and a full bodied mouth feel. You won't believe you're drinking such a low alcohol, low calorie beer. A perfect session ale. Strewth!

Flower Pots Brewery, Cheriton, Winchester, Hants

Buster's Best - ABV 4.2% - Some of Hampshire's finest malted barley and a touch of wheat is combined with Fuggles and First Gold hops to produce a traditional well rounded easy drinking English beer. Full bodied, nutty and biscuit, with a sweet and smooth bitterness. Bronze in colour with a creamy head.

Flower Pots IPA - ABV 6.0% - Brewed in limited batches, this is full of Pilgrim, Progress and East Kent Goldings hops producing an earthy, medium bodied ale with a smooth bitterness. The English hops are blended with malted barley and with hints of citrus, spice and pine with a deep yet warming golden hue. Steady as she goes!

Gritchie Brewing Company, Ashmore, Wiltshire

ESB Ruby - ABV 5.5% - Extra Special Bitter is a superbly balanced Ruby Ale, with a rich toasted flavour and a smooth, clean hoppy finish. From Guy Ritchie's brewery near Tollard Royal.

Moon Lore - ABV 3.7% - A refreshing hop-forward New World Pale Ale with a verdant bouquet and the mouth-watering zing of citrus. Moon Lore marries zesty tangerine with the sweet crisp freshness of greengages. It has a light finish that gently enlivens the palate prior to each new sip.

Hop Kettle, Cricklade, Swindon

Duet 16 - ABV 4.2% - A dual hopped Pale using the same base malt profile with a constantly changing partnership of hops. Duet brings together Ahtanum and Loral varieties for a bright floral character, backed up with hints of spicy cedar and citrus. Which is nice! Gluten Free.

Polaris - ABV 3.7% - A Gluten free ultra pale NZ session ale bursting with fresh pineapple, papaya & mandarin. Balanced with a hint of spice & sweet biscuity malt. Hopped with Motueka, Pacifica and Wai-iti.

Hopback Brewery, Downton, Wiltshire

Rye Tangled - ABV 4.3% - A biscuity maltiness from the rye, with chocolate overtones, will make this chestnut-coloured ale full-bodied but easy drinking. Rye Tangled is brewed with English hops, which give a clean bitterness, with a spicy, fruity finish.

Taiphoon - ABV 4.2% - Taiphoon has a complex recipe involving maize and barley malts infused with two English and three Continental hop varieties, which give this pale, thirst-quenching ale a distinctly hoppy yet flowery palate. The addition of coriander and lemongrass gives a lovely zing.

Plain Ales, Sutton Veny, Wiltshire

Fool's Gold - ABV 3.5% - A pale beer with hints of tropical fruits. Think sitting on a hot beach somewhere. A great all day cruiser!

Livin The Dream - ABV 4.0% - A rusty copper ale with hints of sweet tropical fruits and complex aromas of mango, coconut, lemongrass, elderflower and even a touch of violet and just a pinch of roasted malt to add some colour.

Rude Giant, Wylye, Wiltshire

Rude Best - ABV 4.0% - An inviting, traditional best bitter with a delicate balance of hoppy bitterness and malty backbone. A proper beer!

Rude Lager - ABV 4.5% - A crisp craft pilsner inspired lager. Gentle and smooth malt lingers behind a clean and thirst-quenching finish. Unbeatable on a hot day!

Settle Brewery, Settle, North Yorkshire

American Amber - ABV 4.6% - Flavours of caramel and toffee from roasted malts pair perfectly with American citrus hops. Not a brewery of many words!

Attermire Pale - ABV 4.3% - Hoppy citrus flavours are perfectly balanced with earthy bitterness in this classic premium pale ale from Yorkshire.

Small Paul's Brewery, Gillingham, Dorset

Enigma - ABV 5.0% - Past beer of the festival winner, Paul Smith's latest creation. A pale amber beer using a proportion of Melanoidin malt which gives it a more smooth and malty characteristic. Deceptively drinkable given its strength.

Southwark Brewing Company, London

Bankside Blonde - ABV 3.8% - Bankside Blonde is traditionally brewed with English Pale Ale Malt giving a light gold appearance. I 00% Mosaic hops gives floral, tropical, and fruity tones that create a most refreshing, easy drinking summer ale.

Routemaster Red - ABV 4.2% - A modern style Red Ale. Pale, Bestmalz RedX Malts give a subtle red hue with a hoppy flavour of peach and passion fruit. Hopped with Sorachi Ace, Centennial & Cascade.

Stonehenge Ales, Netheravon, Wiltshire

Danish Dynamite - ABV 5.0% - A strong golden coloured IPA. Good hop and fruit aromas and complex flavours develop into a beautifully balanced full-bodied after-taste with hops and fruit to the fore.

Pigswill - ABV 4.0% - An amber coloured session best bitter traditionally brewed using barley, crystal and wheat malts. This session bitter is full-bodied and not so bitter, but rich in hop aroma which gives the beer a delightful after-taste.

Three Daggers Brewery, Edington, Wiltshire

Daggers Edge - ABV 4.7% - A golden amber Premium Bitter which is brewed with Maris Otter malt with First Gold hops used in the bittering. The floral, citrus Slovenian hop, Styrian Dragon is used for the aroma.

Tinhead - ABV 3.9% - This is a light, crisp amber ale with tropical citrus notes with a slight bitterness and Lime/Passion fruit aromas.

Twisted Brewing Co., Westbury, Wiltshire

Heritage Mild - ABV 3.4% - Dark Mild was the 'go-to' session beer for decades (ask your Dad about Watneys Party Four), and whilst it might not be 'de rigueur' at the moment, let's breath fresh life into the cult which is a Dark Mild. Go on, try it!!

Urban Legend - ABV 4.3% - A refreshing and balanced West Coast Pale. Light malt and citrus hop in the aroma are replicated on the palate, with the soft citrus notes complementing the malty background and dry bitterness which continue into the after-taste.

The Wine....

There is Canti Prosecco (11%), Champteloup Rose from the Loire (11%), Tierra Sagrada Blanco from Spain (11.5%) and The Whale Caller Shiraz Cab Sauvignon from South Africa. (13%). All for the bargain price of just two cheeky drink tokens.

The Food....

Check out the burgers and scrumptious sausages from Manor Farm Butchers - which are always fab! We will also have Vegan & Vegetarian options, as well as a perfect plump pig on the Hog Roast on Saturday. Don't forget the cakes and scones on Saturday afternoon and there are also Crisps and snacks which are available from the Pavilion.

Lilley's Cider Barn, Frome

Mango Cider | Sweet - ABV 4%

An aromatic sweet cider expertly blended with exotic mango to create a mouth watering flavour.

Cheeky Pig | Medium-Dry - ABV 7.5%

A lend of perry and cider that is golden amber in colour. Made using crisp Somerset apple cider and fresh tasting perry, resulting in a refreshing drink, packed full of flavour with a fairly dry texture.

Bee Sting | Medium-Sweet - ABV 6.8%

A wonderful blend of perry and cider that is golden in colour. A glorious fresh tasting cider with a pear aroma.

Sunset | Medium-Sweet - ABV 6%

A rich and fruity rustic cider bursting with apple flavour. Cloudy and Medium Sweet.

Gwynt Y Ddraig, Pontypridd

Happy Daze | Medium-Dry - ABV 4.5%

Fruity, apple aroma, well balanced finish. Alight very easy to drink cider.

Sandford Orchards, Crediton, Devon

Devon Red | Medium - ABV 4.5%

A perfectly balanced, refreshing, medium cider named after the rich red soil that gives the Orchards their distinctive quality.

Broadoak, Clutton, N. E. Somerset

Broadoak Draught | Dry - ABV 6.0%

A dry rustic cider, fruity bursting with apple flavour and aroma.

The Spirits....

Bombay Sapphire | Bramble Gin - 37.5%

Rounded fruit sweetness balanced by a helping of peppery woody juniper, plus a hint of citrus cutting through.

Greenalls Gin | Wild Berry Gin - 37.5%

Balancing luscious & juicy berry notes with warming spice & juniper.

Kopparberg | Passion Fruit & Orange Gin - 37.5%

Infused with botanicals of juniper, lemon zest and coriander for a bold and balanced taste.

Aviation | Batch Distilled American Gin - 42%

Infused with botanicals of juniper, lemon zest and coriander for a bold and balanced taste.

Tanqueray | Flor de Sevilla Gin - 41.3%

Natural flavours of Seville orange and orange blossom, bittersweet and zesty.

Whitley Neil | Rhubarb Ginger Gin - 43%

Essence of rhubarb adds a tart crisp edge whilst the real ginger warms the palate.

Opihr | Oriental Spiced Gin - 40%

A very smooth, rounded London dry gin, soft camphor, some sweetness and oriental spices.

Kopparberg | Strawberry & Lime Gin - 37.5%

Infused with botanicals of juniper, lemon zest and coriander, cleverly combining sweet and tangy tastes.

Weymouth Cider Co., Dorset

Leg Wobbler | Medium-Sweet - ABV 7.5%

Strong and very drinkable with a crisp refreshing taste. Chances are you'll like it so much your legs will wobble.

Monkey Madness | Medium-Dry - ABV 4.5%

Golden in colour, a very apply pleasant to the mouth, yet still farmhouse style cider.

Strawberry Cider | Medium-Sweet - ABV 4%

A cider liberally imparted with Strawberries – gorgeous colour and a wonderful aroma.

Rhubarb Cider | Medium - ABV 4%

A medium cider with a subtle taste of rhubarb juice.

Perrylicous | Sweet - ABV 7.5%

Sweet but incredibly refreshing with a glorious fresh tasting pear flavour and a wonderful pear aroma.

Bristol Cider Co., Bristol

Sixer | Medium - ABV 6%

Perfect for those that want the traditional cider experience with a smooth long finish taste, made with West Country cider apples.

Dorset Nectar, Bridport, Dorset

Old Harry Rocks | Dry - ABV 6%

A vintage landmark dry cider. A scrumptious alchemy that celebrates Dorset's Jurassic Coast. 2015 & 2017 British Champion Organic Cider Cup winner.

JJ Whitley | Raspberry Vodka - 35%

Fruity, rich raspberries on the nose and palate with an enticing berry finish.

Dead Man's Fingers | Spiced Rum - 37.5%

Notes of Pedro Ximénez Ice cream, creamy caramel and followed by vanilla, cinnamon, nutmeg and subtly sweet undertones of orange.

Mount Gay | Barbados Rum - 40%

Notes of fresh vanilla, sweet almond, ripe banana and mocha.

The Kraken | Black Spiced Rum - 40%

An aroma of caramel, toffee and spice, with a flavour of cinnamon, vanilla and nutmeg.

Red Leg | Vanilla Ginger & Pineapple Spiced Rum - 37.5%

A vibrant drink with sweet notes of pineapple and vanilla and Caribbean spices.
